Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve along one of South Africa's most scenic routes, passing Hout Bay. Enjoy a cruise to Seal Island, to view seals and sea birds at Duiker Island. During summer, several thousand Cape Fur Seals – along with the rare Black Cormorant – lollop leisurely among the kelp beds. Travel along Chapman's Peak Drive (conditions permitting). Continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. The scenery en route to Cape Point, at the South Western tip of the reserve, is particularly lovely in spring when wildflowers carpet the landscape. The new lighthouse – the most powerful in the world – beams an electric light of 19 million candle power across the ocean. Ascend to the top of by The Flying Dutchman funicular. Visit the penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Then drive through the historic naval base town of Simon's Town. End the day with a stroll through Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens (time permitting/optional cost). The Treetop Canopy Walkway gives visitors the opportunity to experience the forest from high above the ground. The galvanized steel structure meanders through trees and branches, with sections that crown above the forest. Return to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Cape Town hotel.

## **Private Full Day Oudtshoorn Tour**

All our primates live in a natural environment. Enjoy a visit to the Tsitsikamma National Park. The Tsitsikamma National Park is situated at the heart of the picturesque Garden Route. Tsitsikamma is a Khoisan word meaning, "place of much water". In 1964 when it was proclaimed, it became the first Marine National Park in Africa and today the Park incorporates 80 km (50 miles) of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes. The Tsitsikamma's spectacular scenery includes the Indian Ocean breakers, pounding rocky shores beneath 180 m high cliffs, ever-green forests and fynbos rolling down to the sea.
