Iguazú Falls Full-Day Excursion

A full-day tour that involves walking the three circuits that weave around the waterfall. Each of these offers different vantage points from which to view the water. The Upper Circuit (1 hour) is made up of 2,624 feet (800 m) of walkways elevated above the jungle floor to avoid disrupting the natural paths of indigenous fauna. The Lower Circuit (2 hours) is 5,250 feet (1,600 m) long and is also made up of elevated walkways, which go directly below and around the falls. The Devil's Throat (2 hours) is the star of the show. Later pick up and transfer to hotel. Overnight at Puerto Iguazu hotel.
